WHO IS COVERED

This is the fourth report in the FEC Disclosure Series and focuses on the finances of the two major national parties and their political committees during the 1976 campaigns. Although these committees represent only a small portion of the 1,088 party-related political committees across the country which filed reports with the FEC, they account for a significant portion of the party-related money involved in the 1976 Presidential and Congressional camapigns.

The financing of Federal elections by the two "national parties" was actually reported by 35 different political committees: 18 Democratic and 17 Republican. These political committees have been divided into five categories depending upon their function in the party structure and the type of candidates they generally support.

All data in this report is broken down by party; by category of party political committee; and by the individual party political committee. Totals for each category, party, and committee are also given.

CATEGORIES OF NATIONAL PARTY POLITICAL COMMITTEES

National Party Committees

These six committees are generally considered to be the standing political committees of each major party.

National Party Committee Affiliates

This subgroup of eleven party political committees represents particular constituencies, or includes committees which were formed for special events.

National Party Convention Committees

These four committees were established for the sole purpose of administering the national party conventions.

National Party Congressional Committees

These nine political committees assisted in the election of party candidates for the Senate and the House of Representatives.

Party Identified Committees

These five political committees do not constitute a part of the party organization, but are nevertheless partisan in nature and, in addition to assisting in the election of Federal candidates, also serve an educational function.

WHAT DATA IS SHOWN

The tables and graphs show, by party, the figures for total receipts and expenditures, as reported (gross) and as adjusted (net). The various types and amounts of receipts and expenditures are shown, with a dollar breakdown of contributions and the number of contributions when available. Finally, cash on hand as of December 31, 1976, outstanding debts and the final balances are given.

In assessing the significance of the total figures for the 1976 campaign, it is important to examine both the REPORTED and ADJUSTED totals. Because of the large amounts of money flowing between party committees in the form of loans, transfers and in-kind contributions, there is often a large difference between the two totals. Only the adjusted totals represent the net income and the costs involved in campaign activity.

Adjusted figures were derived as follows:

The totals were calculated from all reports submitted by a single committee and the following items were subtracted: any loans which had been subsequently repaid; any contributions which had been refunded; expenditures rebated; and Treasury notes and Certificates of Deposit bought and subsequently redeemed. These items were all, in effect, transactions required to be disclosed by the Act and not real campaign costs. Other items subtracted were transfers received from related committees and earmarked contributions, since they would be reported as a receipt by another committee or candidate.

REPORTS AND PERIODS COVERED

All data was taken from reports and/or amendments submitted for the period January 1, 1975 through December 31, 1976, and received by March 20, 1977. Each political committee was required to file quarterly reports of receipts and expenditures (or monthly if so requested and approved by the Commission), plus pre- and post-election reports.

GUIDELINES ON THE USE OF THIS DATA

Data has been derived from figures as reported by the political committees and is subject to change through subsequent FEC audit or amendment to the reports.

All reports are available for public review and/or copying at the Federal Election Commission, "provided, that any information copied from such reports and statements shall not be sold or utilized by any person for the purpose of soliciting contributions or for any commercial purpose." (2 U.S.C Section 438(a)(4))

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GLOSSARY

RECEIPTS

- Total Contributions Adjusted Contributions received from individuals less contributions refunded.
- Transfers Contributions received from other political committees, i.e., state and local party committees and non-party committees.
- Miscellaneous Income Includes interest, certificates of deposit, outstanding loans, sales and collections, public funds and other non-contributory income.
- Total Receipts Adjusted Encompasses the following items: contributions, non affiliate transfers, and miscellaneous income.

EXPENDITURES

- Operating Expenditures Includes such items as overhead, media, consulting and fundraising expenditures. Payment is made directly to the vendor.
- 441(a)(d) Expenditures Expenditures made on behalf of a Federal candidate by the party committee paid to the vendor. The title of these expenditures refers to the part of the FECA which describes these expenditures and defines their limitations.
- Transfers to Candidates Contributions made directly to Federal candidates.
- Total Expenditures Adjusted Operating expenditures, 441(a)(d) expenditures, and transfers out to candidates, less refunds and rebates. This category does not include transfers out to affiliated committees, loan repayments and earmarked in-kind contributions.
- Balance Represents the cash on hand less the amount of outstanding debts and obligations. This is calculated for statistical purposes only since it does not reflect the possible conversion of loans to contributions.

SUMMARY OF NATIONAL PARTY POLITICAL COMMITTEES RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES 1976 Campaign


National Party Committees constitute an average of 71.6% of Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted.

National Party Convention Committees hold second place with an average of 13.1% of Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted.


National Party Congressional Committees constitute an average of |11%| of Democratic Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted.

National Party Committee Affiliates and Party Identified Committees combined constitute the remainder of 4.3% of Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted.

OTAL RECEIPTS ADJUSTED




TOTAL EXPENDITURES ADJUSTED

SUMMARY OF NATIONAL PARTY POLITICAL COMMITTEES RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES 1976 Campaign

- National Party Committees for the Republicans constitute an average of 65.2% of Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted.
- Republican National Party Congressional Committees constitute an average of 29.3% of Total Receipts and Expenditures Adjusted, a group of increasing importance.
- The remaining 5.5% is divided between the National Party Convention Committees, the National Party Committee Affiliates, and the Party Identified Committees.






